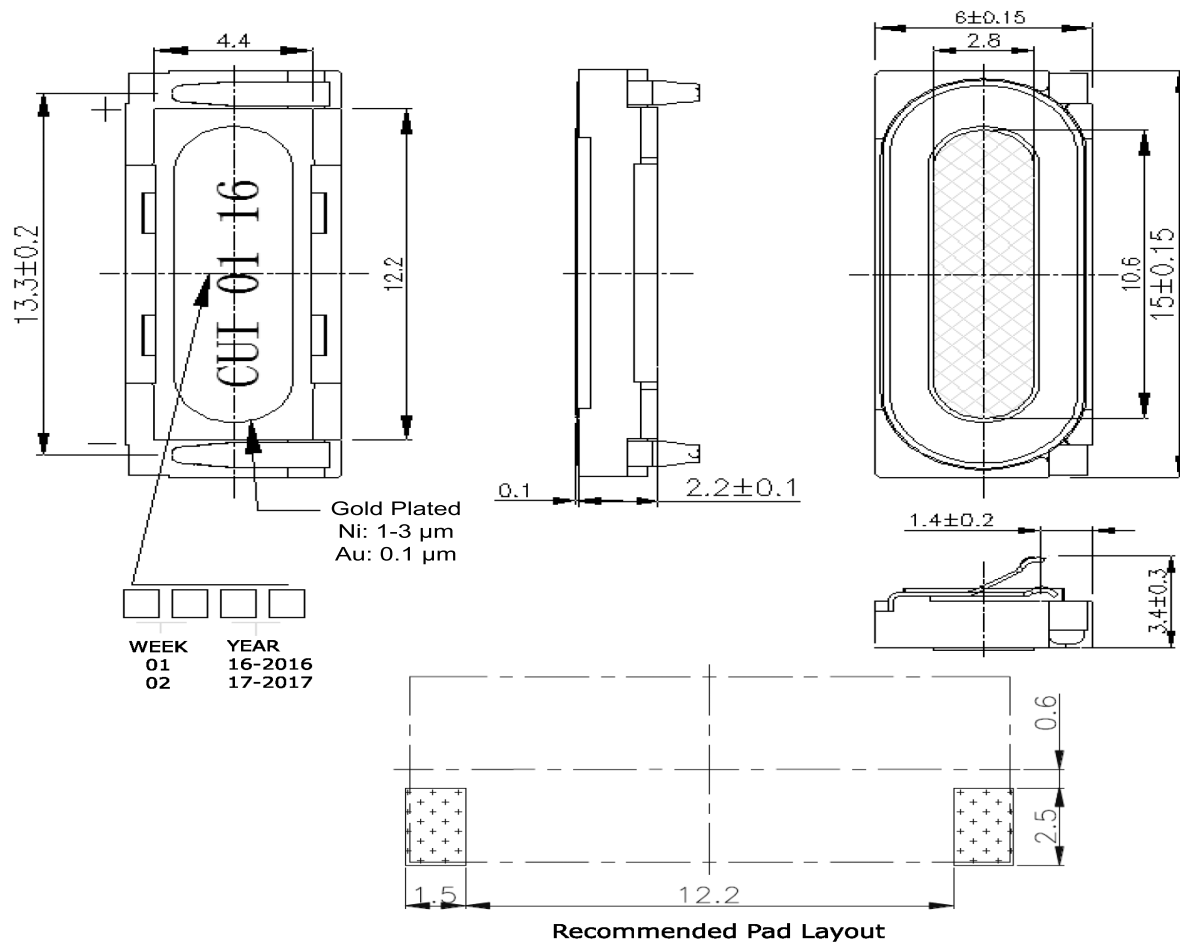

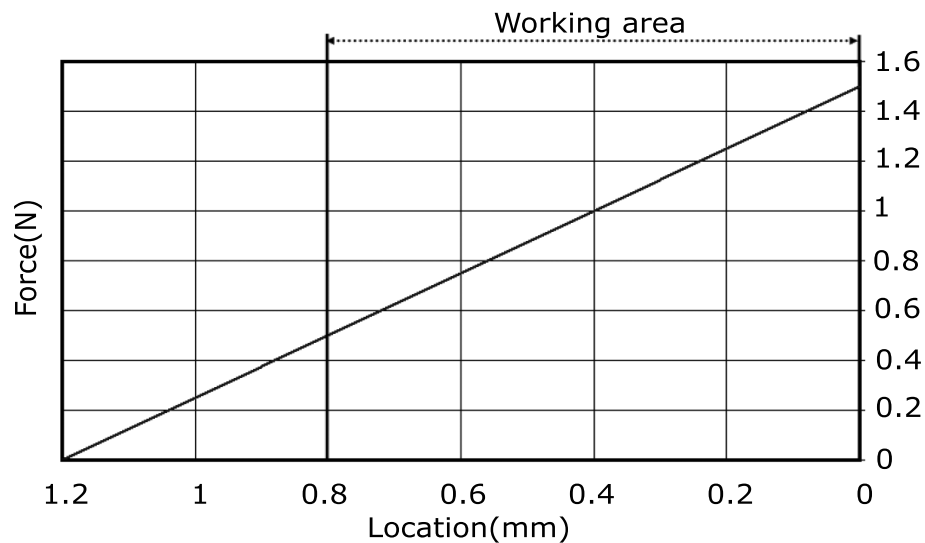

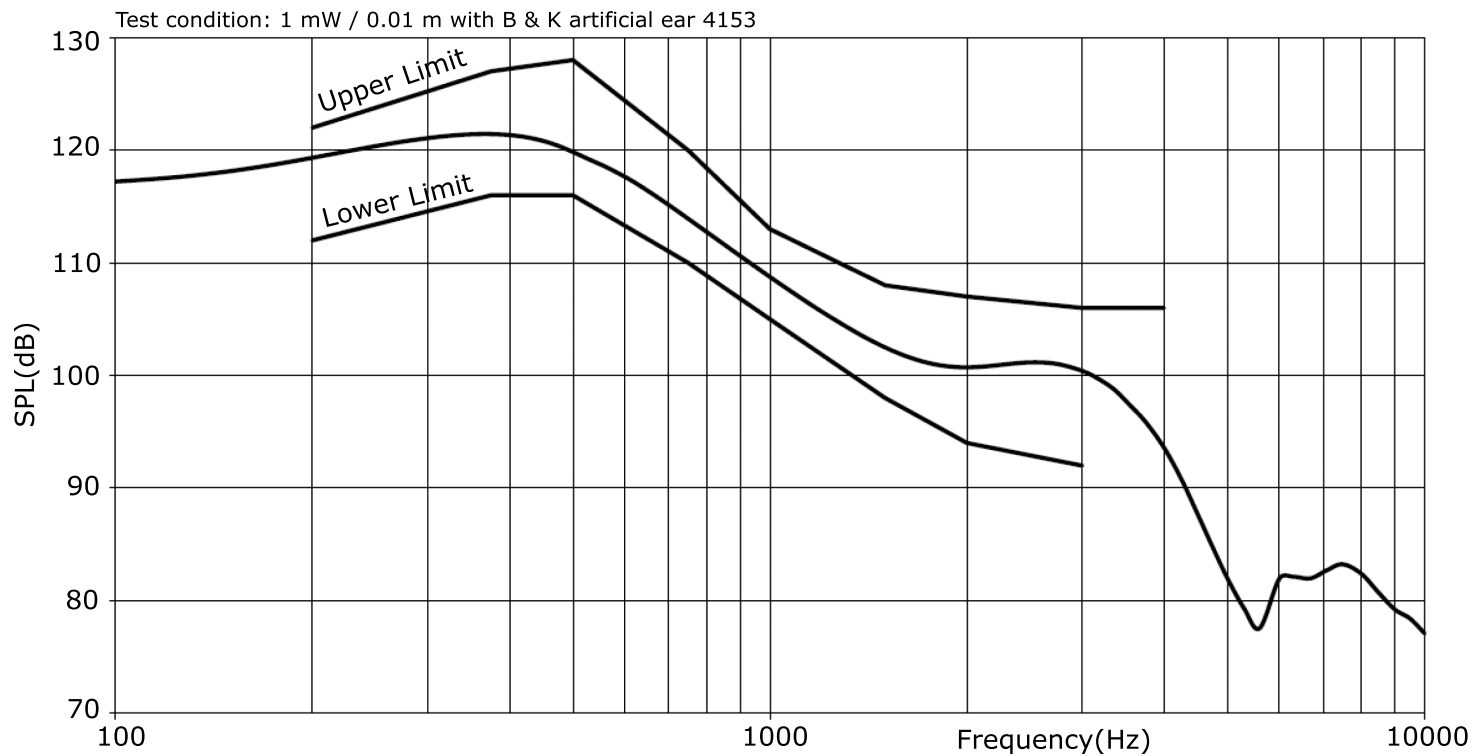


Force Progression Of One Spring Contact

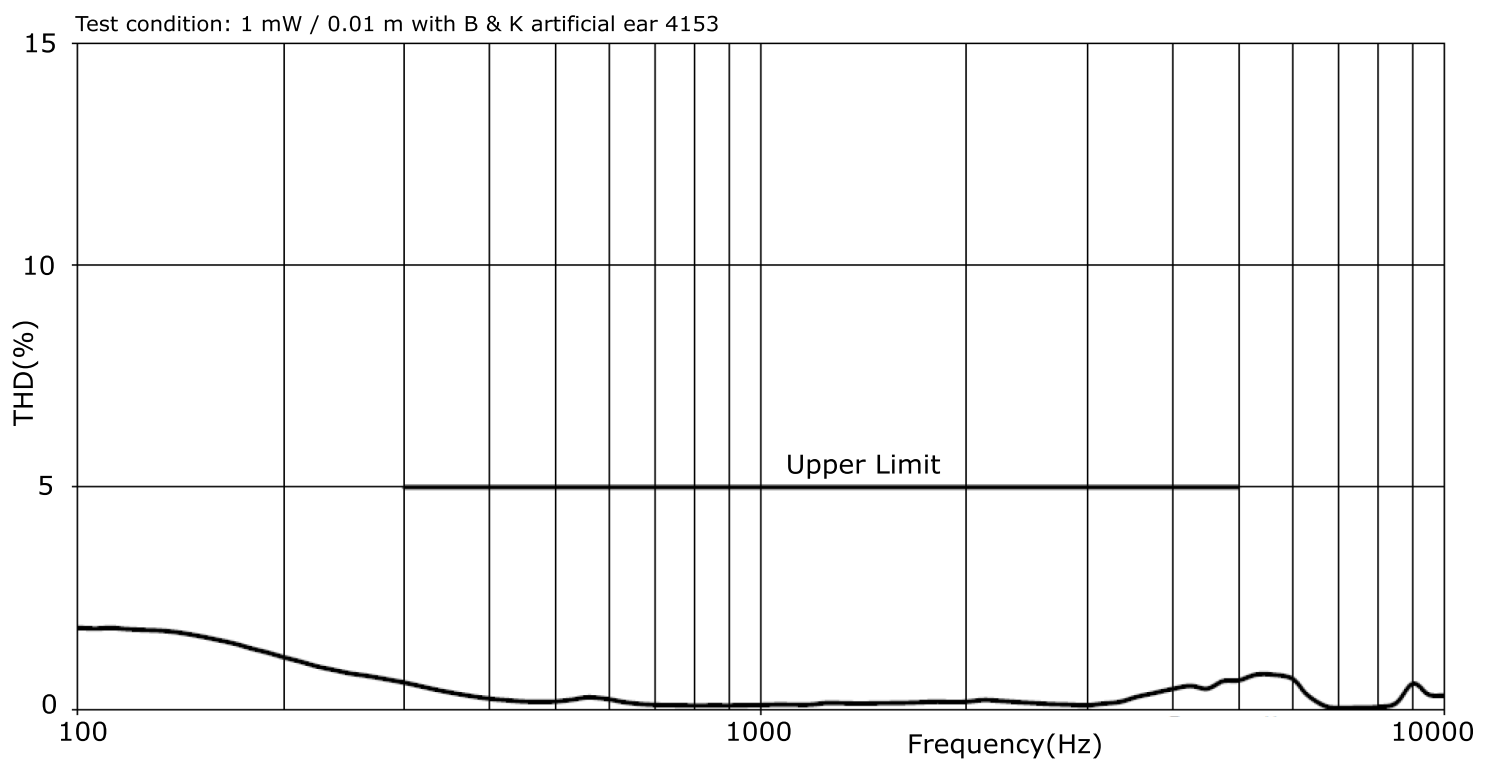


RESPONSE CURVES

Frequency Response Curve



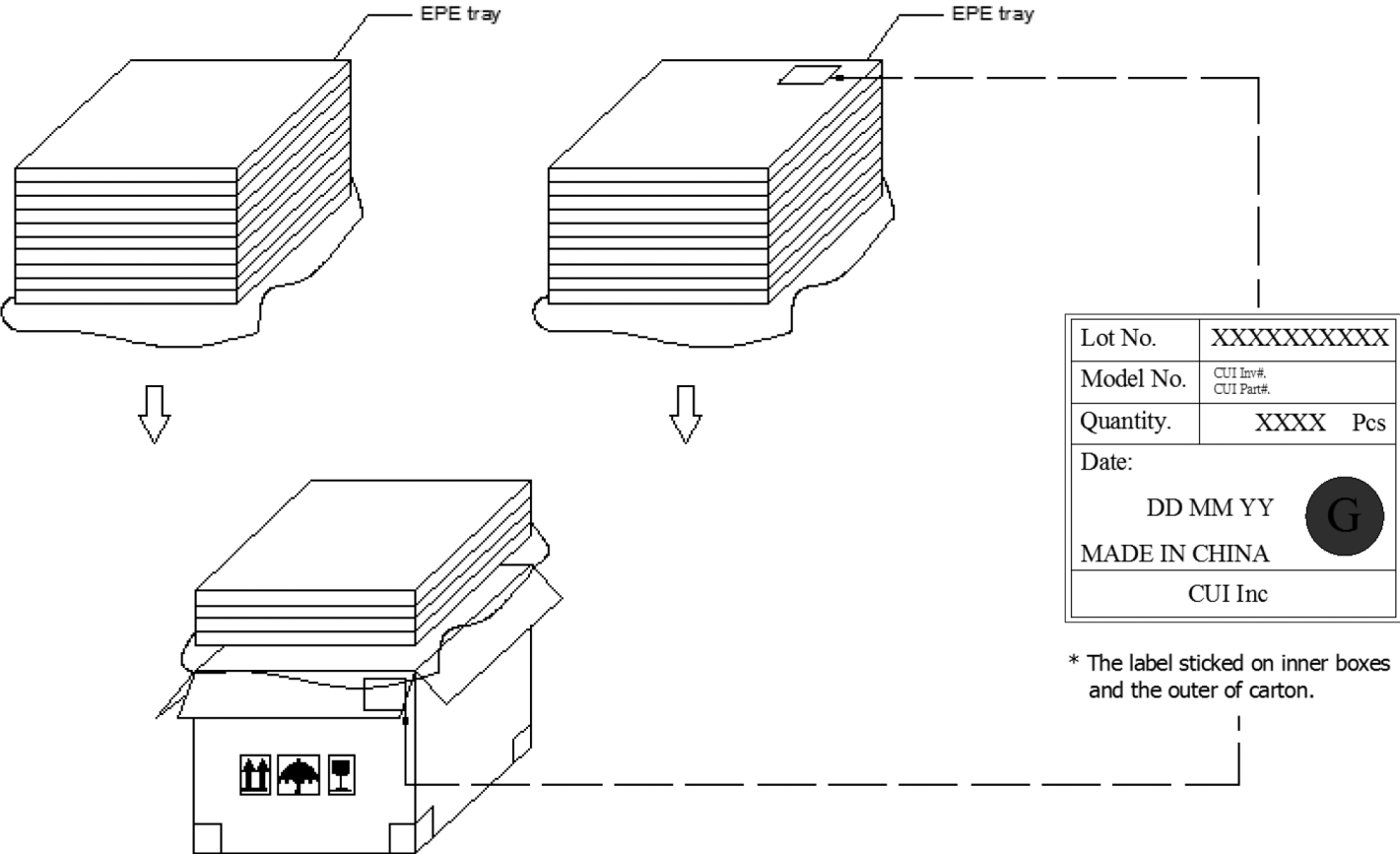
Total Harmonic Distortion Curve
