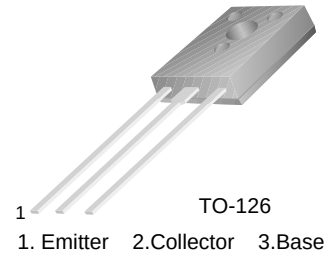

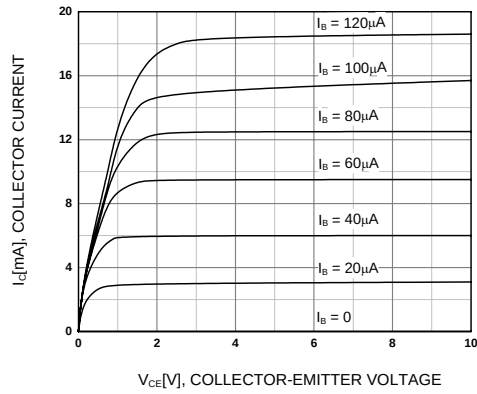


Figure 1. Static Characteristic

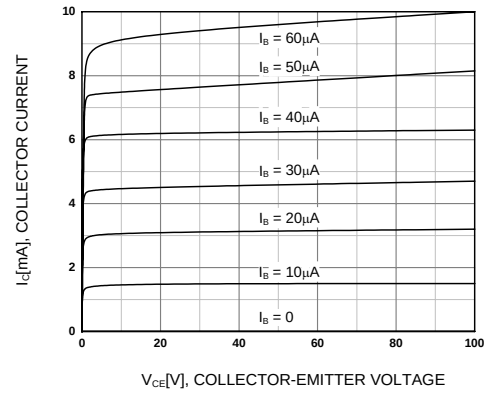


Figure 2. Static Characteristic

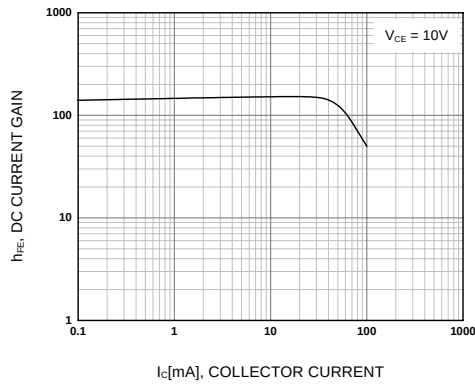


Figure 3. DC current Gain

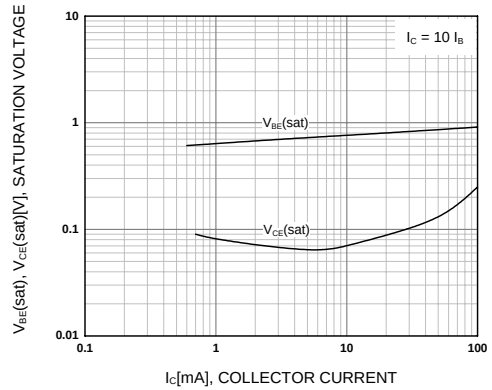


Figure 4. Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage
Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

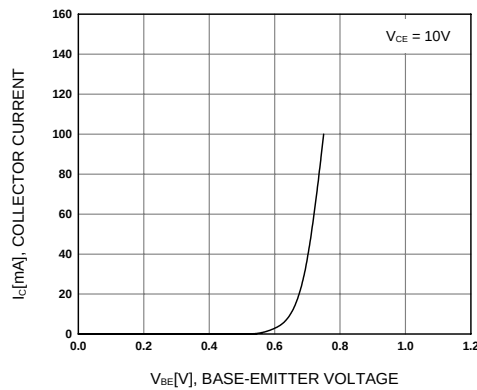


Figure 5. Base-Emitter On Voltage

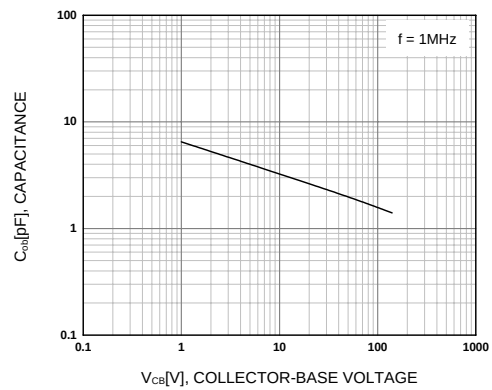


Figure 6. Collector Output Capacitance

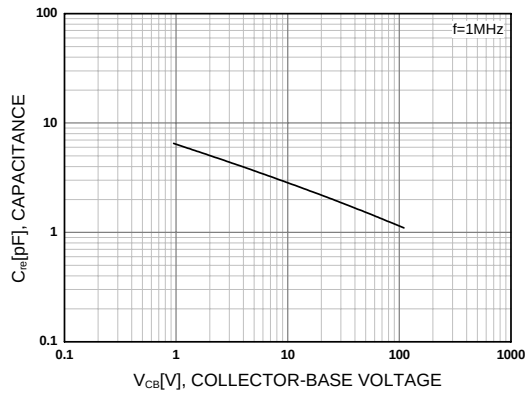


Figure 7. Reverse Transfer Capacitance

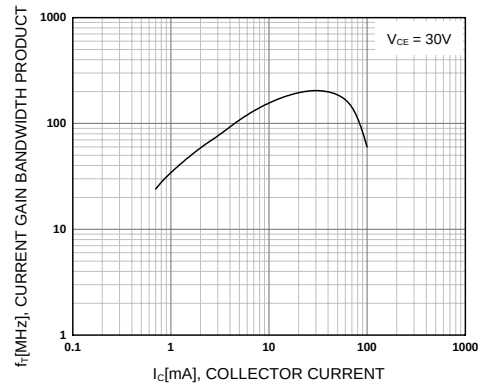


Figure 8. Current Gain Bandwidth Product

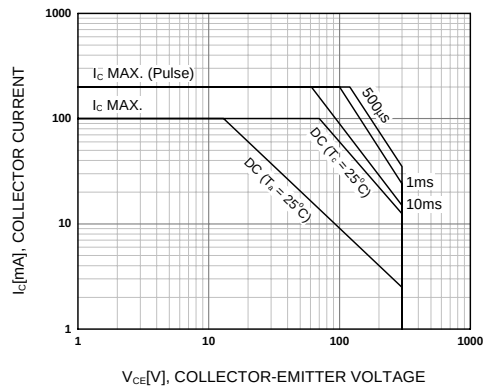


Figure 9. Safe Operating Area

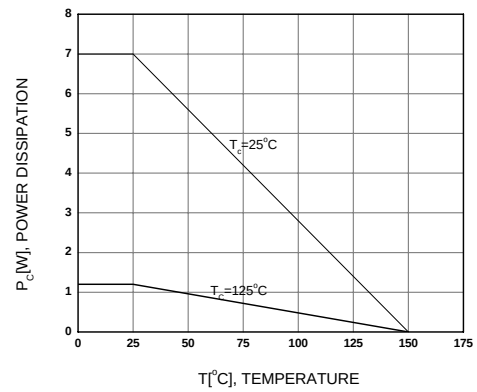
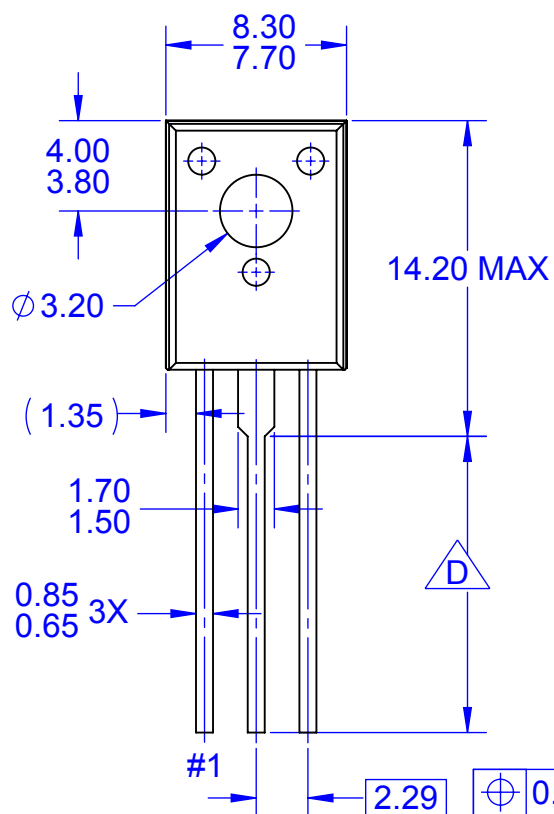
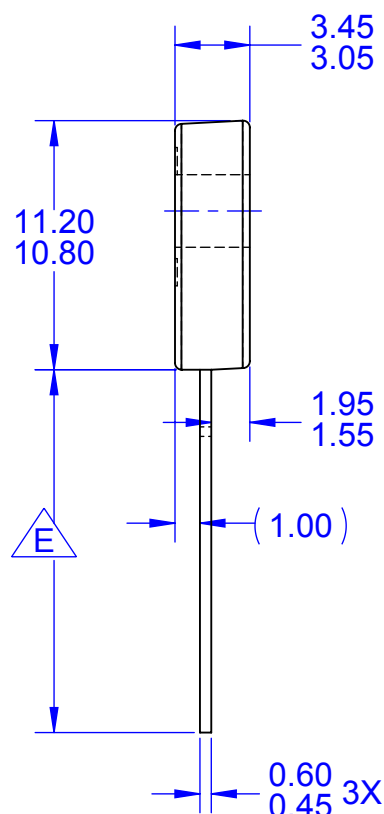


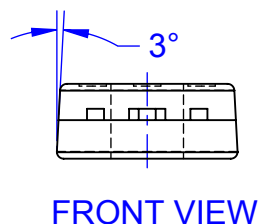
Figure 10. Power Derating
